

Anmi Fujii, 7 years old, was born in Singapore to Taiwanese and Japanese parents. She started learning violin at the age of 3. In 2016, she was shortlisted to perform solo at the Singapore International String Conference (SISC) lunch-time concert at the NUS YST Conservatory of Music. In 2017, she won the High Achievement Award in Violin Performance at Forte Musicademy, and was selected to perform solo at the Victoria Concert Hall in the Forte Eclat annual concert. In March 2018, Anmi won the 4th Prize in Cheers Taiwan International Music Competition in the 1st-2nd grader violin category. She is currently learning violin under the tutelage of Ms Andrea Lin at Forte Musicademy.

Anmi has also performed in chamber music and orchestra, in the 2014 SISC, the 2016 Forete Eclat annual concert, the 2016 SISC, and the 2017 Forte Chamber Music Concert. As a dancer, she has also participated in the Octoburst! 2017 children's festival at Esplanade accompanying the Forte String musicians.

Anmi has passed Grade 5 internal violin practical exam at Forte, and scored Grade 1 ABRSM music theory exam with distinction. She has scored 98/100 for Grade 2 internal theory exam and 48/50 for Grade 2 internal aural exam at Forte.

Anmi also performs for St Hilda's Church on family service days, as a violin soloist, accompanied by her older sister Aimi - Piano and younger sister Yumi - Voice.
