

Kamadjaja is a song created by Mochtar Embut. Mochtar Embut is a composer from Indonesia. His famous works include "Suita Kaliurang", " Di Wajahmu Kulihat Bulan ", and " With The Deepest Love from Jakarta" which earned an award at the World Pop Song Festival in Japan in 1971. In addition Mochtar also created the song " Mars Pemilu "which is used as a march for General Election in Indonesia. This Kamadjaja song is inspired from Kamadjaja, the god of love. Kamadjaja is represented as a young, handsome man with green skin who wields a bow and arrows. His bow is made of sugarcane with a string of honeybees, and his arrows are decorated with five kinds of fragrant flowers. He is a god of love and very elegant. Kamajaya married to a Goddess Kamaratih, These gods and Goddess always keep the salvation of mankind in this world, especially the Pendawa family. Kamajaya even called The God of Arjuna, because he was very fond of Arjuna. In this song we can hear Mochtar's interpretation for the strains of Javanese gamelan that are very distinctive.
