Valse Melancolique, Op. 2, No.3 – Vladimir Rebikov

Vladimir Rebikov, born on May 31st – Krasnoyarsk, Siberia, Russia. Died on October 1st, 1920 – Yalta, Crimea, Ukraine. Was a late romantic 20th-century Russian composer and pianist.

Valse melancolique.. The pieces is devided in 2 section which the 1st section very lyrical and sad tone and use more Rubato to espress the feeling..

And the 2nd section is a bit brighter tone in waltz tempo.. The last section is back to the first theme but there is 2 part voice in the right hand melody..
