

Domenico Scarlatti

Scarlatti was a composer from the Baroque period, and was one of the few Baroque composers whose music switched from Baroque to the early Classical period. He is most famous for his 555 keyboard sonatas, including the Sonata in F minor.

Sonata in F minor, Kp 239: One distinctive feature in Sonata In F Minor, as well as other of Scarlatti's pieces, is the music's Iberian folk music style and influence.

Peter Sculthorpe

Peter Sculthorpe was an Australian composer. His more famous works include his orchestral music like Kakadu. He was one of Australia's list of people who made exceptional musical contributions to the country

Night Pieces - Stars: Night Pieces is a series of 3 pieces of music: Snow, Moon and Flowers, Night and Stars. Stars carries the motivic structures introduced in Snow, Moon and Flowers. This particular feature is a reference to the concept of Setsugekka, translated to 'Snow, Moon and Flowers' which represents how snow, the moon, or flowers can symbolize or resemble one another.
